The original Sunbeam-Talbot owners' club has been re-established as a fundraising organisation to help protect a piece of automobile heritage.

We have two main purposes. The first is to preserve the vehicles for future generations to enjoy. We intend to do this through club members subs (minimum £20 per member per year) and also through various other fundraising activities.

As replacement parts are becoming increasingly difficult (often impossible!) to source, the money raised will help fund tooling costs to make new parts. These tools will be loaned to third parties who will manufacture and sell the parts on S.T.O.Cs behalf thus keeping your cherished classic alive.

S.T.O.C will get a percentage from the sale of these items, plus a fee for the loan of the tool which will then be ploughed back into the fund. It will also retain ownership of the tool itself forever thus safe-guarding the availability of a part previously seen as being financially unviable for commercial companies (e.g. Sunbeam-Talbot Spares) to produce.

Our second purpose is to promote the marque. In order to secure additional funding we need to go beyond the traditional promotional areas.
